## **Robin Templar Williams, APLD** **Renowned British garden designer and APLD Regional Workshops Chair**

Robin Templar Williams has over 28 years of experience in the garden design, landscaping and horticultural fields. He is now rightly regarded as one of Britain's leading, practicing garden designers and in recent years has undertaken major projects in countries as diverse as the USA, Russia, the Ukraine and Japan.



He is joint managing director of a successful UK private training college, Garden Design School, and lectures internationally on a wide range of topics. He has also appeared on British TV a number of times, most recently on Garden Makers, an ITV series presented by Joe Swift. Robin is a former Vice Chairman and Fellow of the UK's Society of Garden Designers (SGD) and currently sits on the board of the British Association of Landscape Industries (BALI) as the Director responsible for Designer Membership. He has been a certified member of the USA's Association of Professional Landscape Designers (APLD) for many years but, from January 2008, also assumes the position of board director for that organization.

Robin's gardens have won a clutch of medals (including gold) at the Royal Horticultural Society's (RHS) Chelsea and Hampton Court Flower Shows.

Dr. Jules Bruck is the owner of Evolution Landscape Design in Media, PA. She is an Assistant Professor of Landscape Design at the University of Delaware. She has been an APLD member for 6 years and is APLD's National Education Board Director. Her goals as an APLD member and board director are to continue to build relationships with educational institutions and students of landscape design.



### **More about the workshop...**

Garden design encompasses a wide range of different skills and knowledge bases—horticultural and plant knowledge, drafting, IT, soil science, knowledge and construction of hard materials, drainage and so on—Robin will focus primarily on the design principles and the skill of good design for a three dimensional space. The success of a garden design is to some extent subjective. However, adherence to design principles dictates the success or failure of a design, no matter what the style, them or location.

One of the golden rules of good design is the ability to focus on creating the open space and not the solid volume. The open space might be lawn, water, terrace, the solid volumes might be beds and borders or even long grass. It is the shape of the open space that makes the predominant impact in a garden, not the shape of the solid volumes. When we are in a garden we can only read the open space, we see its boundary and its shape, we do not read the whole shape of a solid volume, we only see the front of it. Once this is understood, it has a transformative effect on a person's capacity to design a garden or landscape. The above and more will be discussed in greater depth.
